

HOW TO SET TIME AND DATE

- 1. Unscrew the crown counterclockwise and pull out to first click position.
- 2. Turn the crown counter clockwise to set the date.
- Pull the crown out to second click position.
- 2. Turn the crown counterclockwise to set the time.3. Push the crown back into normal position.
- 4. Allways securely screw in the crown.

You do so by pushing the crown towards the watch while screwing it clockwise until it's 100% tight.

If this is not done correctly you risk that moist and dust will enter your watch!

HOW TO WIND UP THE MAINSPRING

- Rotate the crown clockwise at normal position.
- Wind turning the ratchet wheel screw 8 times. It will start to move naturally after shaking slightly.
 - (with winding machine. Full wind up conditions rotary speed: 30 rpm Operating time: 60 minutes.)

ACCURACY

1. Static Accuracy: -20~+40 seconds per day
